Saturday Seminars

Two Hands, Two Colors - Saturday, Feb. 6, 2010 Time: 10:30 to 12:30 Cost: \$25

Learn to work fair isle patterning using the two handed technique in only two hours! This method allows you to work without having to untwist your yarns. You will learn how to carry the color not used and read a graph, as well as European knitting. Materials: The Warm Ewe's Fair Isle Earflap Hat pattern, 2 to 4 colors of light bulky weight yarn, a 16" size 9 circular knitting needle & markers. Note: Earflap Hat pattern calls for 4 colors of yarn, also size 9 double point needles and size 7 circular needles 24" long to complete the hat.

This one includes the best of the best! Different ways to cast on and bind off, increase and decrease, fix mistakes, finishing techniques and more! Don't like that "jog" when you bind off a neckline in the round? Or when you do rows of bind offs at a neckline or armhole? I'll show you ways to avoid that. We'll talk about how to figure out what size sweater to make according to the pattern you're using, and how to avoid the "ladder" when you knit with double point needles. Materials: Light colored smooth bulky weight yarn, US size 10 or 10 ½ knitting needles, double point needles size 10 or 10 ½, a yarn needle and a size J or K crochet hook.

Learn to Knit Socks - Saturday, Feb. 27, 2010 Time: 10:30 to 4:30 Cost: \$50

Use double pointed needles, turn a heel and kitchner stitch your way to a warm pair of socks! We will make a worsted weight infants sock incorporating all the techniques needed to knit a basic pair of socks. Materials: 50 yards worsted weight yarn, size 5 double pointed needles, Yankee Knitter pattern #29 for socks, scissors & a yarn needle.

Crochet for Knitters - Saturday, March 6, 2010 Time: 10:30 to 12:30 Cost: \$25

Learn the basics of crochet and how to use it with your knitting! We'll use a crochet hook to bind off knitted stitches, make crochet trim and a picot edging. Crochet is a great way to trim baby sweaters, scarves & afghans. Materials: Light colored smooth worsted weight yarn, size 7 or 8 knitting needles & a size G or H crochet hook. **Homework!**: Please knit an 8" square in stockinette stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) with yarn and needles listed above before class begins at 10:30. DO NOT bind off, end having just purled a row.
